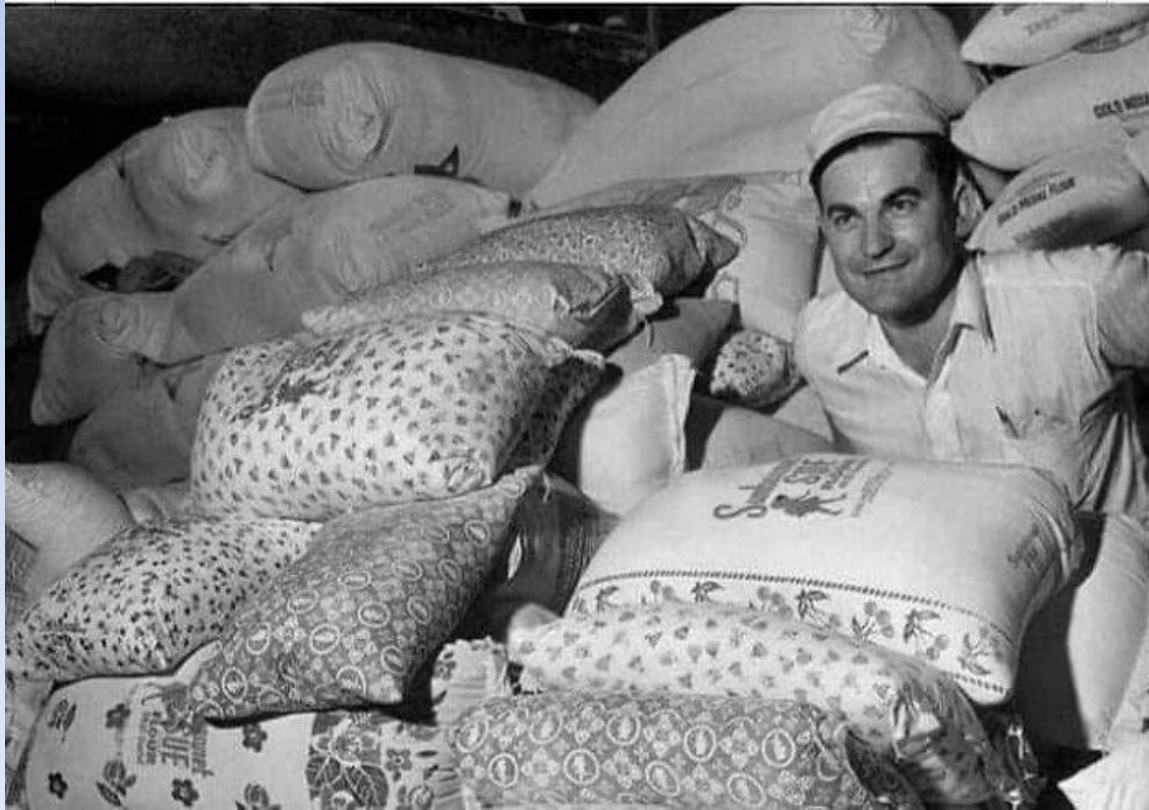

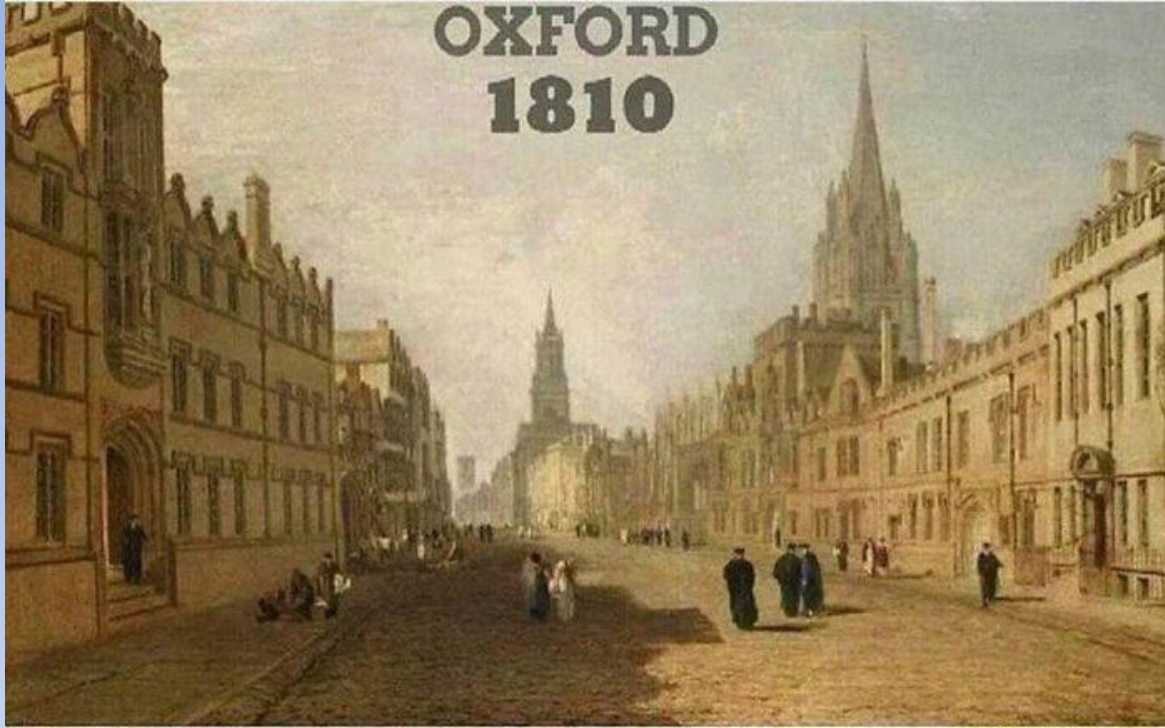
Letter from a trapped

air.

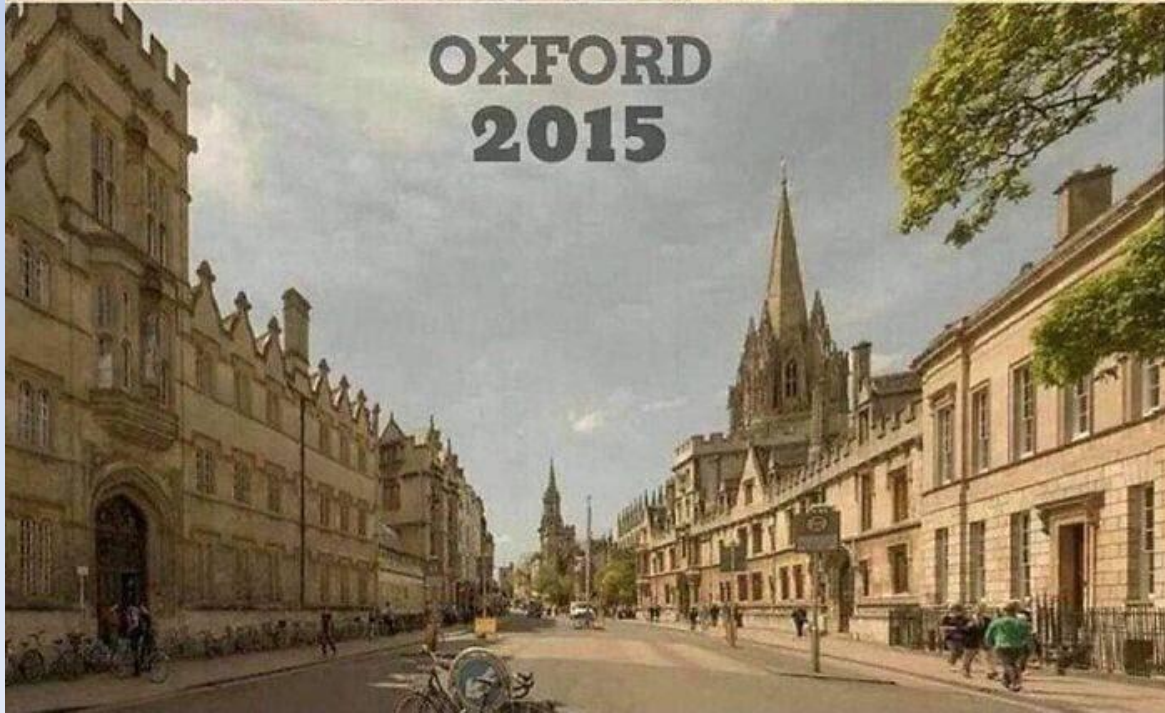
Ellen I want you to live right

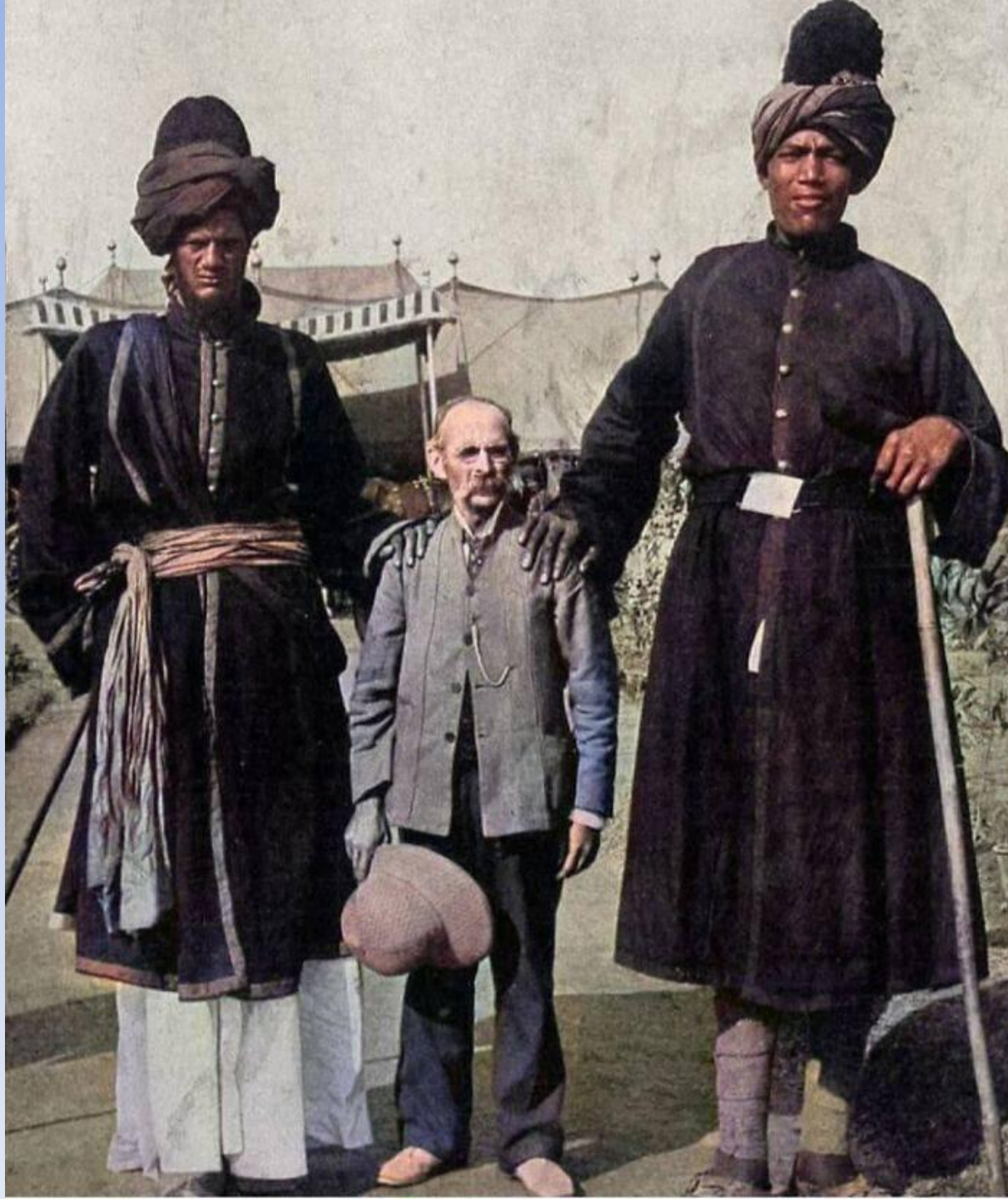



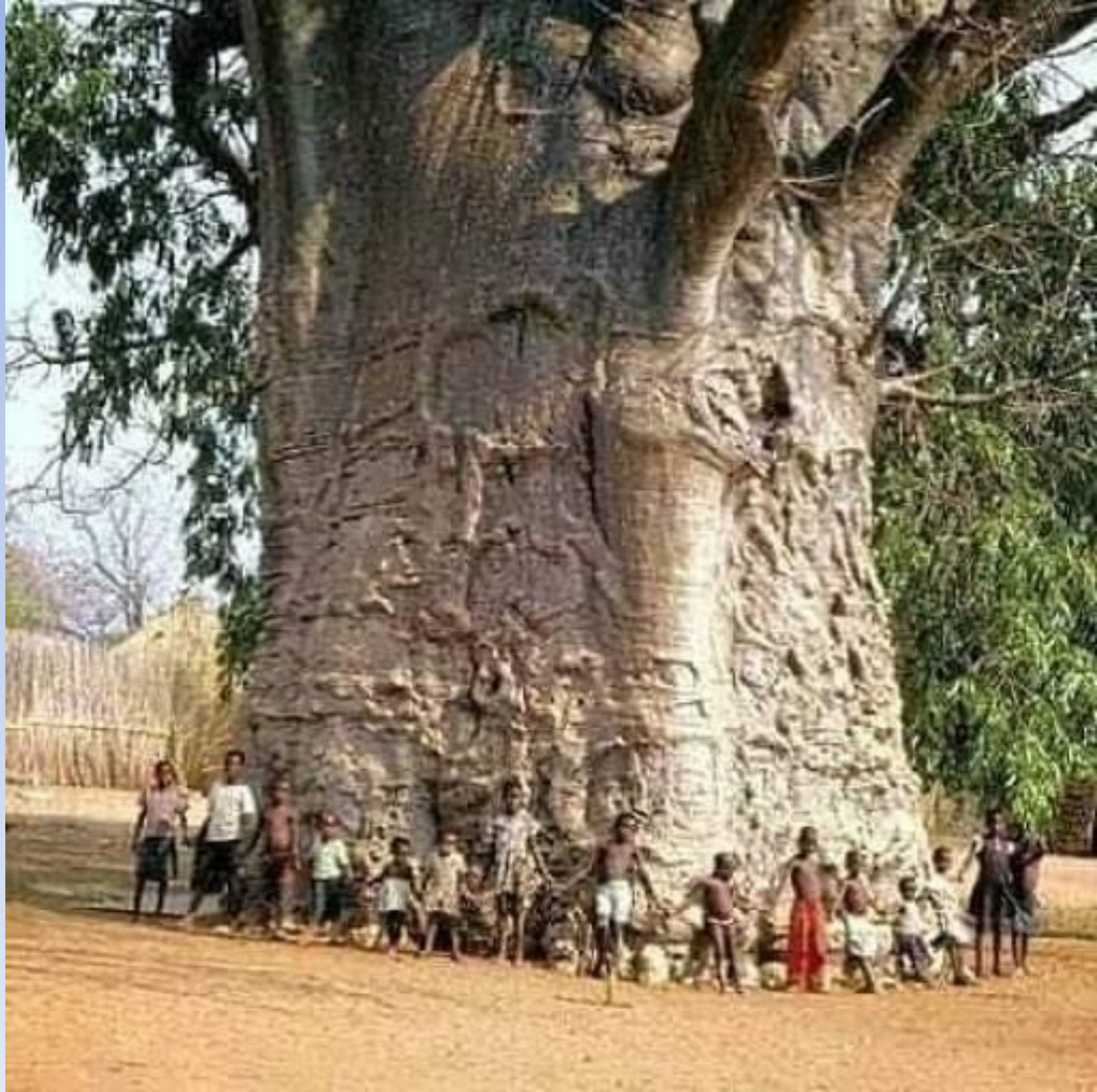

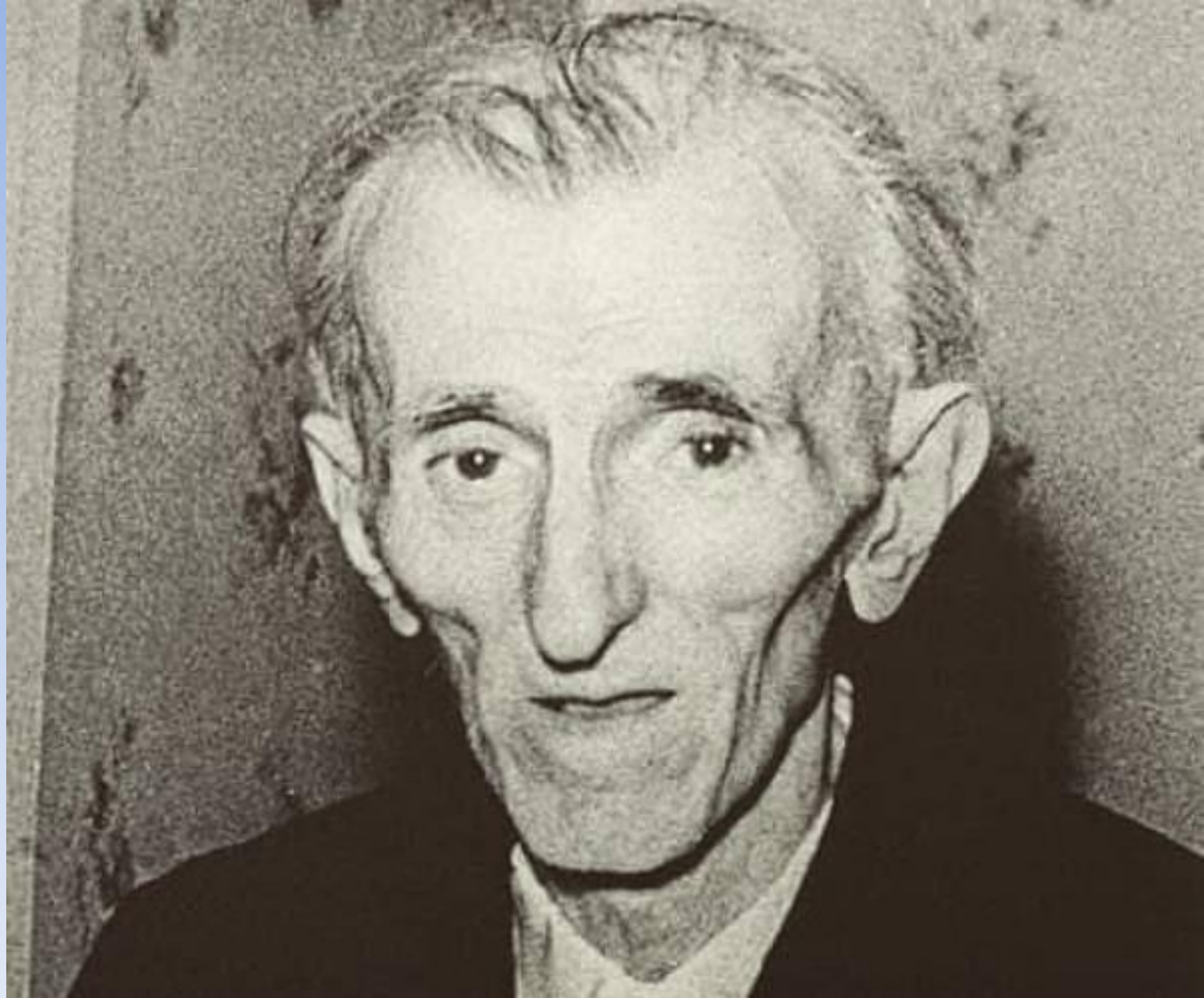
